4-Day Cape Cod Escape

Day 1: We will **depart at 8:00a from the Calendar House Senior Center, 388 Pleasant St., Southington** for a delightful 4-day escape to Cape Cod. Extending some 70 miles into the sea, the Cape is home to both natural beauty and quaint colonial villages. You can walk pristine beaches, revel in the arts and culture, and reclaim childhood memories of seashells, sandcastles and saltwater taffy. We will **meet our local guide** who will take us on a tour of the John F Kennedy Memorial, the Korean War Memorial, Hyannisport and a view of St. Francis Xavier Church, the summer parish of the Kennedy family. After a brief check in at our hotel, the **Holiday Inn Hyannis**. Dinner is included this evening. (D)

Day 2: Our guide will meet us at the hotel this morning, after breakfast, and will escort us to the ferry docks. We will be boarding the Hy-Line Ferry to Martha's Vineyard, where upon arrival we will board a local bus for a sightseeing tour. We will learn about the history and lifestyles of the islanders as we pass through Vineyard Haven. There will be free time for lunch and shopping in the historic whaling town of Edgartown. We will complete our day on the island in Oak Bluffs. Upon our return to the mainland, we will enjoy dinner, where lobster is on the menu (alternate selection available)! (B,D)

Day 3: After **breakfast**, our **local guide** meets us at our hotel for a **full day of touring**. This morning, we travel to **Provincetown**, located at the extreme tip of the Cape, formerly known as the 'Province Lands', the pilgrims landed here first before they decided to settle across the bay in Plymouth. We will enjoy a **dune buggy tour**, where we ride along the shoreline of the protected lands of the Cape Cod National Seashore. Take some time this afternoon to enjoy the wonderful variety of restaurants, shops, and galleries that make this artists/fisherman village so unique. As we return to Hyannis, our guide will point out the 'dune shacks' where famous artists and writers became inspired to create their art. We will travel historic Rt. 6A, the Old King's Highway, a scenic byway winding through centuries of Cape Cod history. Along the way we will see a windmill, a Cape Cod lighthouse and will stop and visit the **Cape Cod National Seashore Visitor Center**. There will be time to freshen up at the hotel before we enjoy a very special **dinner** aboard the **Cape Cod Central Railroad**. Dinner this evening is a five-course event, as we ride the rails passing by cranberry bogs, natural woodlands, and lush marshes as we travel to the Cape Cod Canal and back. (B,D)

Day 4: We will check out of our hotel following **breakfast**, and travel to **Cape Farm & Cranberry Co.**, located in Harwich MA. We will have a **cranberry bog tour**, where our bog guide will show us examples of an existing bog, currently in production, and will discuss the stages of the cranberry growing process. There are two methods of harvesting, and we may even see it happening. This afternoon we depart for home with sand in our shoes, seashells in our pockets and many fond memories of our escape to the Cape! **Estimated return to Southington is 5:30pm**. (B)
