This afternoon we take our reserved orchestra seats for **Sight & Sound Theatre's** new production of **"Joshua."** From the banks of the Jordan River to the towering walls of Jericho, Joshua is a miraculous adventure. Journey alongside the people of Israel as they navigate their new-found freedom in an unforgiving wilderness. When Joshua is called to replace Moses as their faithful leader, tensions mount in the midst of dwindling supplies and approaching armies. With one last fortified city standing between the Israelites and the Promised Land, unexpected help emerges from behind enemy lines and Joshua's trust in God's plan is put to the ultimate test. **Dinner** this evening is included after the show. Day 3: **Breakfast** is included this morning, before we depart for **Philadelphia, PA**. The center of activity for America250!
