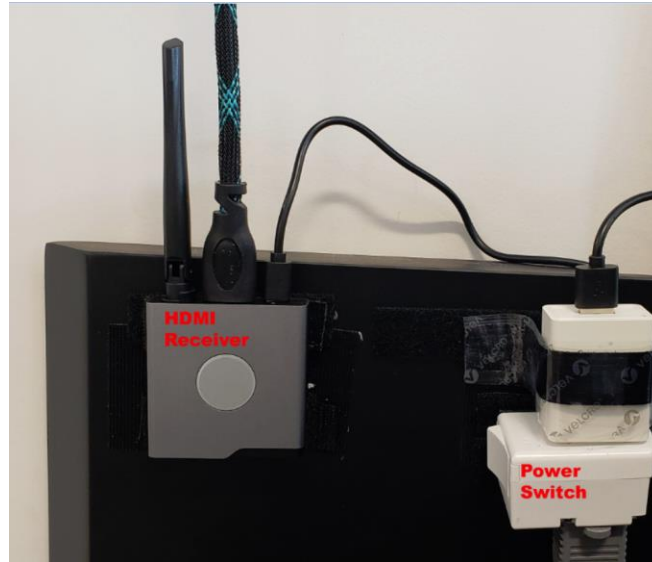


## Apple iPad **Wireless** LG TV Display.

This description is specific to the Calendar House LG television set-up and may not work with other systems.

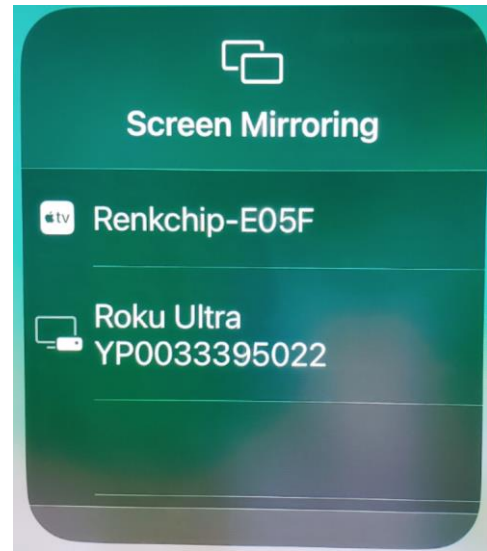
- 1) Turn on the LG television.
- 2) Switch on the HDMI receiver power. Note that a faint blue light will eventually show around the circular switch on the receiver confirming that the receiver is on.



- 3) Use the LG TV remote and click the button at the top right. A list of connection options will appear. Use the LG remote arrow keys to scroll to the HDMI<sub>2</sub> option and then click the "OK" button.
- 4) In a few moments a view similar to the picture below should appear. If the TV image is NOT entitled "IOS Mode" but shows a title of "Android Mode", click the circular button on the HDMI receiver ONCE. This action should switch the view to "IOS Mode".



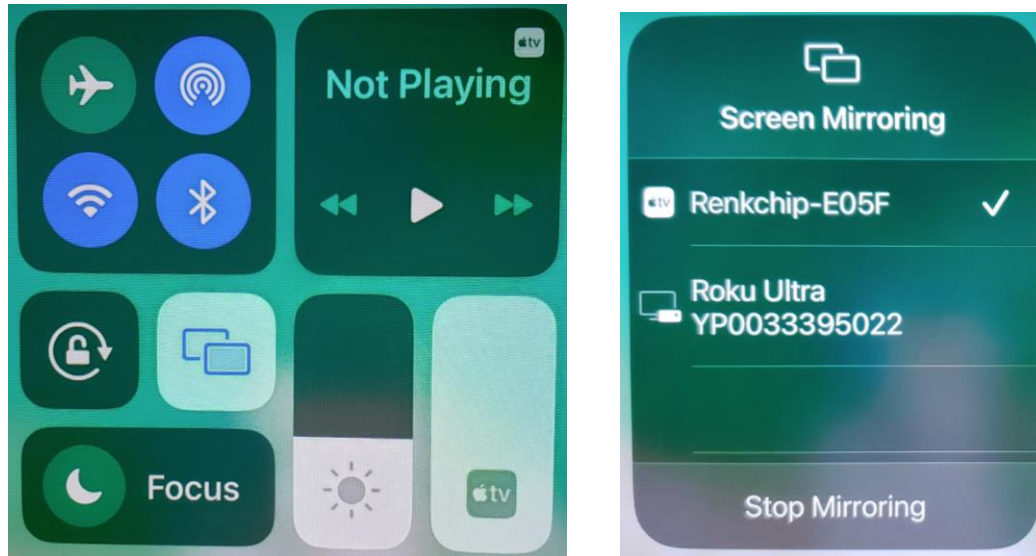
- 5) Log onto your iPad and when running, swipe DOWN from the TOP RIGHT corner of the screen and the image below left should appear on the iPad. Click the screen Mirroring option which is the icon that has the two overlapping rectangles and a view similar to the picture on the right below should appear.



- 6) Look at the TV screen and look for an item like “Device Name : Renkchip-xxxx” where the xxxx will be a number unique to the HDMI receiver in use. Look back at the iPad and the Screen Mirroring area may list a number of connection options including the “Renkchip-xxxx” number that is on the TV. Tap the “Renkchip-xxxx” number and the iPad screen should appear on the TV. Tap anywhere on the screen that is NOT in the Screen Mirroring area and both screens will return to a normal iPad view and you can begin your presentation.
- 7) Note that all of item 6) should be carried out without too much delay or the HDMI receiver or the iPad may time out. If this happens touch the iPad screen away from connection images twice to clear the connection views and then press the HDMI receiver button once and wait for the “Android Mode” option to appear, then click the button again to return to the “IOS Mode”. Then do items 5) and 6) again.
- 8) All the normal iPad facilities will be available for your presentation and all screen changes will be copied to the TV reasonably quickly. When you have finished your presentation, it is important to shut the system down properly as described on the next page.

## Essential Shutdown Process

- 9) On the iPad, swipe DOWN from the TOP RIGHT corner of the screen and then tap the screen Mirroring option (which now may have a white background) to get back to the Screen Mirroring option icon. Tap on the “**Stop Mirroring**” option to stop the iPad transmissions. Then tap away from the selection options to return to the basic iPad screen.



- 10) Turn off the power to the HDMI receiver. Confirm that the faint blue light around the circular switch on the HDMI receiver goes out as you switch.
- 11) Use the LG TV remote device to turn off the television.
